Share the Plate

This Sunday's **Share the Plate** collection will benefit **Greater Williamsburg Outreach Mission**. GWOM has grown to 20 area faith groups, including WUU, which are working with community partners to assist the homeless. Many WUUs volunteered last Febuary when we hosted the emergency shelter. We began then to realize the need for our community to recognize and assist our most vulnerable citizens. GWOM is preparing to take the work one step further by implementing a new assistance model, with WUU participation. GWOM volunteers will start by helping one or two families to rise from homelessness to self-sufficiency. An estimated \$20,000 will be needed each year to house and assist "Friends in Need". GWOM is asking each member faith group to generously contribute soon so that we can begin working with people. Just as WUU was one of the first members to join GWOM, we are hoping WUU will be one of the first members to financially support this new initiative.
