CAPITAL CAMPAIGN ENDS--A HUGE SUCCESS!

We celebrated on Sunday with cake! Thanks to **Allen Cooke** and **Kerry Mellette's** Capital Campaign leadership, to the dozens of **campaign stewards**, and to the generosity to so many **members and friends** for making this campaign such a success.

Sunday, January 18, 2015: It was time to celebrate with the announcement that the Capital Campaign to build our future is officially over.

- Last summer, our UUA Financial Advisor estimated that we could comfortably raise \$800,000 with a stretch goal of \$1,250,000.
- Last fall the Capital Campaign set our Confident Goal at \$1,000,000, our Stretch Goal at \$1,250,000 and our Aspirational goal at \$1,800,000.
- On Sunday, Les Solomon, BOF Chair, announced that the campaign closed with gifts of \$1,425,476.29! We anticipate additional gifts of around \$25,000 from the Southeast District as a result of our application to the Chalice Lighter Grant Program, bringing our total to about \$1,450,000!
