THE ANNUAL APPEAL OFFICIALLY BEGAN SUNDAY, JANUARY 26TH - AND YOUR PLEDGE IS IMPORTANT

We have an annual appeal goal for the July 2014-June 2015 year of \$331,000, about 3% greater than the current year. Your pledges pay for over 80% of our annual budget and keep the chalice lit and the doors open. An annual pledge is our way of giving thanks for the services we receive from a dedicated minister and staff and allows us to support our WUU community and our social justice outreach.

For the next 5 Sundays, your Stewardship Committee will have a table set up outside the sanctuary to distribute pledge packets and collect pledges. Please stop by before or at the end of the service to pick up your personal packet.
