Following extensive discussions with WUU leadership and members, the architects at Guernsey Tingle Architects have gathered information from the congregation on critical space needs. Comments collected at those meetings can be read at: http://wuu.org/wordpress/?page_id=14052

The architects will meet with the WUU Design Build Team on March 18 to review input from the congregation and discuss engineering reports on site and building constraints. The Design Build Team will stress some overarching perspectives and design goals that represent liberal religion and WUU mission, goals and principles.

Guernsey Tingle Architects will present their findings and talk with the congregation about next steps at the March 23 meeting for all members, immediately following the Sunday worship service.
