Mandala

Mandala Coming to WUU April 6

Sand mandalas are a tradition of Tibetan Buddhist monks and use symbols to heal; monks typically spend eight years training in sacred geometry before participating in their art of mandala making.

Caroline Hardy, WUU member and professor at Thomas Nelson Community College, is a mandala facilitator and yoga instructor with 500 hours of preparation and training.

The sanctuary will be open from 4-6:30pm, Monday, April 7-Friday, April 11 to view the creation of the mandala. The Williamsburg community is invited to add to the mandala on Monday and Tuesday, April 7 & 8, from 4-6:30pm.

Martha Kiger, mentor to Caroline Hardy and a Unitarian Universalist from Asheville, NC, will join WUU for the final ceremony known as the 'dissolution' on April 12th at 2:30pm

THE ANNUAL APPEAL ENDS SOON

WUU needs everyone who benefits to lend a hand by making a pledge. The appeal will end in the next week, if we are able to hear from those of you who have made a pledge in the past (or are new members) and have not made a pledge yet.

As of Thursday, March 27th, we have received approximately \$284,426 in pledges from 148 pledging individuals and families. So, we have 86% of our goal. For the 2013-14 pledge year we had 180 families and individuals contribute. So we still have yet to hear from many past donors.

POETRY, ANYONE??????


