#### DON'T FORGET THE ANNUAL APPEAL - YOUR PLEDGE IS IMPORTANT

Is it your turn? For the last month, we have heard inspiring messages from Ben Puckett, Katharine Fournier, Jennifer Ryu, and Catharine Laarhoven on why they chose to pledge.

As of Monday, February 24<sup>th</sup>, we have received \$222,250 in pledges from 100 pledging individuals and families. So, 4 weeks into the appeal, we have 67% of our goal. For the 2013-14 pledge year we had 180 families and individuals contribute. So we still have yet to hear from over 40% of the congregation and would like to complete our work in the next few weeks.

For the next 2 Sundays, your Stewardship Committee will have a table set up outside the sanctuary to distribute pledge packets and collect pledges. If you have not already done so, please stop by before or at the end of the service to pick up your personal packet and make your pledge.
