A Community Dialogue on Medicaid Expansion: Putting People First

The conversation on Medicaid Expansion has become increasingly about politics and not enough about the people directly in need. On **June 10** from **6:30 – 8pm** the Virginia Interfaith Center, the YJCW Branch of the NAACP, and Virginia Consumer Voices for Healthcare are hosting a community dialogue on Medicaid Expansion to be held at the Williamsburg Regional Library Auditorium.

Together, a panel of local and statewide experts and area faith leaders will discuss facts and faith as they relate to closing the coverage gap. Panel experts will talk about what expansion would mean for the Commonwealth, what it would mean for communities locally, and where we are now in the debate. A panel of area faith leaders from diverse traditions will also address why this issue is important to their faith, how Medicaid expansion could impact their congregational members or others in the community they serve, and, why therefore, Virginia's focus must be to putting people first.
