Green Sanctuary

Great news! Starting in July we will have curbside pick-up of plastics of all #s, shapes and sizes, not just the bottle-shaped ones. Even rigid plastics such as stadium cups, flower pots, and toys will be accepted. Every homeowner in James City County, Poquoson, Williamsburg and York County should have received a large wheeled green cart with specific directions about what can and can not be included (e.g.no styrofoam or plastic bags). Please remember to rinse out all food residue. You may include large plastic lids, but not the small plastic bottle tops because they clog up the machinery. This curbside pick-up will occur only every other week so consult the schedule provided with your cart.

The Green Sanctuary Committee is very glad that markets for plastics, paper, cardboard, metal and glass have been developed. We ask that WUU members no longer bring your plastics to the church, but take advantage of your own curbside recycling. Thanks.
