10:00 am "Give Us Back the Ballot" Rev. Sherman Logan

In a 1957 speech titled "Give Us the Ballot," Dr. King spoke plainly about the imperative of equal voting rights .For Dr. King, the right to vote was sacred and foundational. He knew that unfair elections laws did not just hurt minorities or the working poor, they rendered hollow the very essence of American government.

It's a message that's still rings true today as it did then. The 49-year old Voting Rights Act has stood the test of time, but there are new obstacles to the ballot springing up in today's America. Voting rights for so many are under attack.
