UUA Ministerial Options

UUA Minister Categories:

- Settled Minister
 - UUA average 4.5 years trending downward from 6 years
- Transitional Minister (Interim)
 - · 2 years
 - Bridge
- Developmental Minister
 - 4–7 years
 - Focused on specific goals of the congregation
- Contract Minister
 - Part time

UUA <u>Transitional</u> Ministry Handbook Excerpts

 Developmental ministry is a program for congregations which know that they have specific, longer-term transitional work to do

 There may be positive & creative reasons for seeking a long-term transitional minister

Board Motion

WUU needs to select a new minister to start in the fall of 2025. The Board:

- Has studied the two best options:
 - To call a settled minister OR
 - To hire a developmental minister who would serve our congregation for up to 7 years.
- Believes that the developmental minister would best serve WUU at this time
- Will schedule times to meet with the congregation to discuss the reasons for this preference before making a final decision during the April 2 Board meeting.

The Board's Discernment Journey...

- Started with Rev. Laura's resignation in December 2022 following her 4-month sabbatical.
- Board discussions led to pursuing an Interim Minister Search.
- After hiring Rev. Michelle in August 2023, further discussions prepared for the next ministerial decision, considering the pros & cons of settled versus developmental ministers.

Candidate Pool

Settled Minister

Largest pool of ministers

• Includes recent seminary graduates

Developmental Minister

 Intentionally small pool of experienced ministers

Pool is selected by the UUA

TENURE

Settled Minister

- Guidance:
 - UUA <u>Settled</u> Minister Handbook
- Open ended, not specified
- WUU's settled ministers: 6-9 years

Developmental Minister

- Guidance:
 - UUA <u>Transitional</u> Minister Handbook
- Follows the UUA's 4-7 years
- 5 years recommended
- Cannot be called

Contract of either type of minister can be terminated by either party with notice

FOCUS

SETTLED MINISTER

DEVELOPMENTAL MINISTER

- Traditional minister role with congregation feedback through the Board.
- Assist congregation in achieving identified goals for breakthroughs on future issues & progress toward vision.
- Goals developed before matching process; UUA matches with experienced candidates.

Search Process: Committee Selection

Settled Minister

Developmental Minister

- Guidance:
 - UUA <u>Settled</u> Minister Handbook
- Congregation-wide solicitation for potential search committee nominees
- Congregation vote to narrow to top 15
- Board discernment for final 7
- Committee members cannot have other congregational leadership roles or be spouses of board members

- Guidance:
 - UUA <u>Transitional</u> Minister Handbook
- Congregation must be recommended by the interim minister and/or the UUA & have UUA approval
- Small short-term search committee appointed by board
- Includes board members

Search Process: Minister Selection

Settled Minister

10 day candidating at WUU with one finalist – May 2025

 Congregational vote of 90% (often candidate won't accept with less than 95%)

Developmental Minister

- Virtual search in winter/ spring of 2025
- Board approves selection
- Congregational vote not needed

Search Cost

Settled Minister

Developmental Minister

Search & settlement:

\$12,000 – 15,000

Plus moving expenses

Search & settlement:

\$2,000 - \$4,000

Plus moving expenses

Board: Comments

SETTLED MINISTER

- The settled minister candidate pool may not offer an experienced option.
- This choice risks a misalignment between minister & WUU.

DEVELOPMENTAL MINISTER

- Our congregation needs an experienced minister.
- Understanding that a 'developmental' minister doesn't mean we're failing, rather, it's the best path for wuu.
- We're ready for the work ahead.

- WUU meets the three criteria for a developmental decision:
 - 1. Need for deep structural & cultural work
 - 2. The work (goals) can be named
 - 3. The congregation is ready
